

**AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC CO-OPERATION  
BETWEEN PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, NARESUAN UNIVERSITY,  
KINGDOM OF THAILAND AND FACULTY OF PHARMACEUTICAL  
SCIENCES, GRADUATE SCHOOL OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, AND  
SCHOOL OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, KYUSHU UNIVERSITY,  
JAPAN**

The Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Naresuan University, Kingdom of Thailand and the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, and the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Kyushu University, Japan hereby conclude an agreement to promote academic exchange

1. The purpose of this agreement is to develop academic and educational co-operation on a basis of equality and reciprocity and to promote relations and mutual understanding between both institutions.
2. Both institutions undertake to promote and develop academic co-operation in the following ways.
  - (1) Exchange of academic and administrative staff, and students
  - (2) Co-operation in research and the presentation of its results
  - (3) Exchange of academic materials and publications
  - (4) Other educational and academic exchanges to which both institutions are agreed
3. The implementation of each exchange program based on this agreement shall be separately negotiated and determined by both institutions.
4. It is understood that the implementation in any way of co-operation stated in 2 above shall depend upon the availability of the necessary resources and fiscal support of the institutions concerned.
5. The Agreement shall be effective on the date when the representatives of both parties affix their signatures to the Agreement. It shall be valid for a period of five years and the Agreement may be renewed, revised or modified after discussion by representatives of both institutions. The Agreement may be terminated by either party observing a six months period of notice to be given in writing.

**MEMORANDUM ON STUDENT EXCHANGE BETWEEN FACULTY OF  
PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, NARESUAN UNIVERSITY, KINGDOM OF  
THAILAND AND FACULTY OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES,  
GRADUATE SCHOOL OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, AND SCHOOL  
OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, KYUSHU UNIVERSITY, JAPAN**

The agreement for the academic exchange program between the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Naresuan University, Kingdom of Thailand and the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, and the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Kyushu University, Japan as it relates to the exchange of students, shall be implemented in the following way:

**Article 1**

The students participating in the exchange program under the terms of this memorandum shall be selected initially by the home university, and the host university shall make final admission in each case.

**Article 2**

Each year, not more than 2 students may be enrolled as non-degree students at the partner university.

**Article 3**

The period of enrollment of the students shall not exceed one year.

**Article 4**

The host university shall waive application, matriculation, and tuition fees for each student.

**Article 5**

The field of study for each student shall be such that the host university can appoint a qualified advisor and provide an appropriate course of study.

**Article 6**

Each student shall possess sufficient language ability requested by the host university to complete the appropriate course of study.

**Article 7**

Each university agrees to provide documentation of course work completed by each student at the host university.

**Article 8**

The host university shall provide information to each student concerning housing.

**Article 9**

Each university agrees to provide appropriate academic information on the performance of each student.
